PsySSA Award for Community Service 2023

This prize is awarded to psychologists working in any area of specialisation, health services provision, or consulting, and services provided to any patient population or professional clientele in a community setting.

Eligibility

- At least a Masters qualification
- Registered as a psychologist at HPCSA
- Must have been in practice for at least 5 years
- Services should have been provided to client groups or patient populations, including but not limited to:
- Children/adolescents/adults/older adults
- Urban/rural/frontier populations
- Vulnerable populations
- Persons with serious mental illness
- No disciplinary actions against practicing record and/or the nominee

Assessment Criteria

Contribution to psychology should be visible through excellent research, policy development and or programme development.

The nomination form below should be submitted with a letter of support detailing:

The nature of the nominee's work, specifying the contribution to community service psychology by:

- 1. the development of practices, procedures, and methods and/or
- 2. the implementation of practices, procedures, and methods that have impacted a community.

Additional documents required

- CV of the nominee
- Provide evidence or documentation that is available to support the contributions of the nominee. Nominators should provide more than mere testimonials about the impact of a nominee's professional contributions.
- Letters of support from at least two persons impacted by the practitioner.

Judging body and process

- A jury will evaluate nominations.
- Nominations close on 31 July 2023.
- The selection will be made at least two weeks before the PsySSA Congress.
