PsySSA Fellowship 2023

The award is a lifetime achievement award in recognition of a person that has dedicated his/her life to Psychology in South Africa.

Eligibility

- · Nominees for Fellowship should have been members of PsySSA in good standing for a minimum of ten years.
- The nominee must have made substantial contributions in Psychology. This can include service to the Society, scientific contributions, educational contributions, or other important contributions to the development of ourprofession nationally or internationally. Service should involve some aspect of leadership, which could be at aregional, national, or international level. A scientific contribution should entail not only the number of publications, butinclude a pattern of publishing, in nationally or internationally recognised peer-reviewed journals, which contributes to our knowledge in a specific area. Educational contributions should involve excelling and producing results above and beyond the requirements of the job.

Assessment Criteria

- A nomination by a member of the PsySSA Council, seconded by another member of the PsySSA Council.
- CV of the nominee indicating the eligibility criteria outlined above.
- At least three letters of support from other distinguished psychologists, who themselves are members in goodstanding, detailing the eligibility criteria outlined above.

The nomination form below should be submitted (together with the CV and Letters of Support) detailing the nominee's achievements in the relevant area of activities detailed above.

Additional documents required

None. Please see the criteria listed above.

Judging body and process

- Nominations must be submitted to the PsySSA
 Executive for consideration. If deemed worthy they will thereafterserve before the PsySSA Council and, if approved, be ratified at the next Annual General Meeting of the Society.
- Nominations close on 28 July 2023.
- The selection will be made at two weeks before the PsySSA Congress.
