 is obtainable from the website of the WCED at http://www.wced.gov.za or from
 any Public Service Department. Applications without a completed application
 form (Z 83) and/or the requested documents/information will not be considered.
- The post number of the ECKED Bulletin and the name of the post applied for must be indicated on your application form.
- Applicants **must submit a detailed**, **up to date CV** with an exposition of their training, experience, competencies and previous employment record as well as the **names and telephone numbers of three persons** willing to act as referees.
- Shortlisted applicants will be required to submit **certified copies of their original qualifications** (degrees, diplomas, certificates etc.), valid driver's license and their ID document when invited for interviews.
- Shortlisted applicants will be required to submit certified copies of their service certificates which indicate the exact dates of previous employment if these exact dates are not mentioned in their CV's.
- Applicants in possession of a foreign qualification must attach an evaluation certificate from the South African Qualifications Authority (SAQA) to their application forms.
