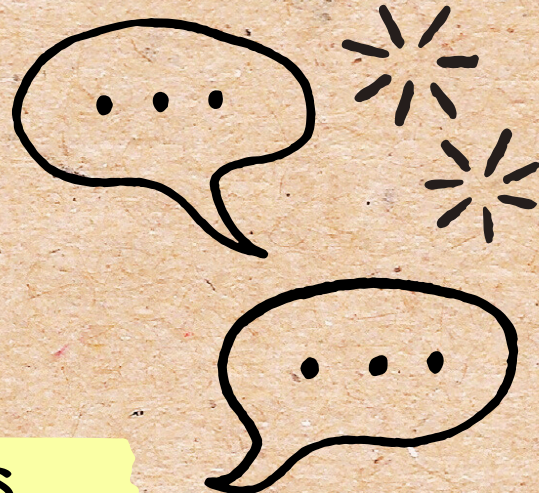
STANDARDS FOR PALLIATIVE HEALTHCARE SERVICES
