# WHO WE ARE

Community and Social Psychology (CaSP) is a subdivision of the Psychological Society of South Africa. ## SEED GRANT 2024

The Seed Grant was established in 2018, with the aim to run an annual competition among CaSP members offering a seed-grant to start or advance a community-based project that provides mental health and psychosocial wellbeing.

# REQUIREMENTS TO APPLY



- Applicants must be registered PsySSA and CaSP members at the time of applying for the grant.
- Applicants must apply as individuals
- Applicants must use the grant for an existing or new project that promotes community mental health and psychological wellbeing.
- The project must show potential to be sustainable beyond the once off funding.
- The grant must be used within the year of being awarded.
