To enhance diversity and expand the journal's global footprint, we strongly encourage applications from African women scholars and international scholars, particularly from the Global South, though all qualified candidates are welcome to apply.

Candidates should have a strong academic record and editorial or peer-review experience. Being a PsySSA member will be advantageous. Associate Editors oversee the peer-review process, collaborate with the Editor-in-Chief and Editorial Board, provide timely and constructive feedback, and promote SAJP regionally and internationally.

Applications should include a letter of motivation detailing the candidate's interest and relevant experience, along with a comprehensive CV highlighting their publication record, editorial activities, and academic leadership.
